SUMMARY (CLINICAL):

Patient presented with sudden onset quadriplegia with breathlessness. Her potassium was 0.5 mmol/l. & ABG analyses showed s/o severe Acidosis. Her further investigations confirmed the presence of type 2 Distal Tubular Acidosis. Pt was further investigated for the cause of late presentation of Distal RTA & it was found to be rare presentation of

Sjogren's syndrome. (Anti SS A was strongly +Ve).

Eventually patient recovered completely & was discharged on oral high dose of potassium & soda bicarbonate with steroids to cover sjogren's syndrome. This was a rare but classical documented case of sjogren's syndrome leading to Distal RTA causing severe hypokalemia presented with quadriplegia.
